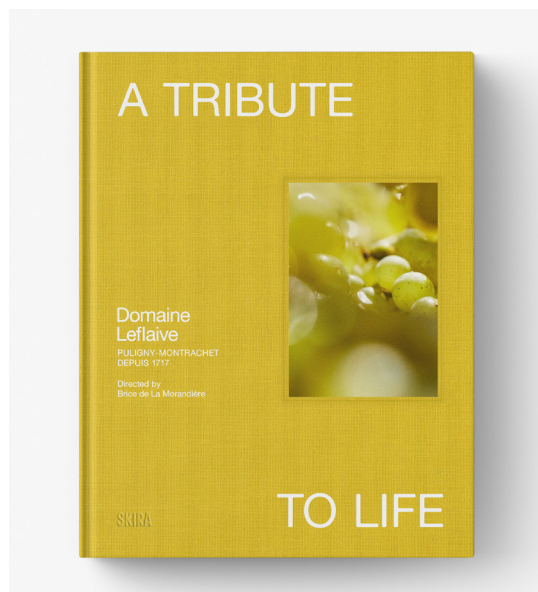


A TRIBUTE TO LIFE

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In September 2026, the publishing house Skira will release *A Tribute to Life: Domaine Leflaive*, the first book dedicated to the iconic family estate in the Côte de Beaune, Burgundy. Neither a monograph nor a hagiography, the publication is conceived as a poetic exploration of the living world, where emotion is cultivated as carefully as the vine. As the pages unfold, *A Tribute to Life* resembles a musical symphony, in which each note contributes to the harmony of the whole. It conveys a profound respect for the land, plant and animal life, as well as the expertise and passion of those who tend the vines and shape our landscapes.

The book also celebrates all those, artisans and artists, who are invited to contribute sincerely to the creation of a shared narrative with the Domaine Leflaive. Hugo Bourny, Michelin-starred chef at Lucas Carton, is one such figure. Working hand in hand with Brice de La Morandière, the family's managing director, and Thierry Thévenin, a botanist, forager, he has devised eight gastronomic creations. These dishes have been developed from plant species found near the estate's vineyards in Puligny-Montrachet and celebrate the beauty of the Burgundian landscape on the plate. Presented prominently at the heart of the book, these unique and refined creations are paired with the estate's wines.

A Tribute to Life is an invitation to immerse oneself in the emotions evoked by a place, the vine, the women and men who work alongside it, and the surrounding natural environment. It is a book to be experienced as much as read, thanks to the richness of its themes and the formal beauty of Jérôme Bryon's photography. A sensitive work, free from post-production retouching.

"What connects us to others and to nature gives rise to incomparable emotions. It embodies the artistic dimension of wine, the poetry it inspires. About Domaine Leflaive:

A Tribute to Life has been conceived as a poetic contribution, open to interpretation by each reader.

Domaine Leflaive has remained entirely family-owned since its founding. Originating from a winemaking lineage dating back to 1717, Joseph Leflaive established the estate from 1910 onwards. Today, the estate extends across 24 hectares in Puligny-Montrachet, including 4.8 hectares of Grand Cru and 10.8 hectares of Premier Cru vineyards. From 2004, it expanded into the Mâconnais, where it now encompasses around twenty additional hectares. Domaine Leflaive is one of the pioneers of biodynamic viticulture in Burgundy. Based on a sensitive understanding of natural phenomena and the rhythms of the earth and the moon, biodynamics excludes all chemical products and seeks above all to nurture soil life. In the cellar, this same philosophy of respect guides the entire winemaking process, in keeping with the purest Burgundian tradition. Harvesting is carried out by hand; fermentations are long and rely on indigenous yeasts. The wines are matured over two years, first in oak barrels and then in vats. Human intervention is kept to a minimum.

The great-grandson of founder Joseph Leflaive, Brice de La Morandière has led the estate since 2015. He continues the family philosophy, grounded in respect for great terroirs, humility in the face of natural forces, and a rigorous, ongoing pursuit of excellence in both vinification and maturation.
